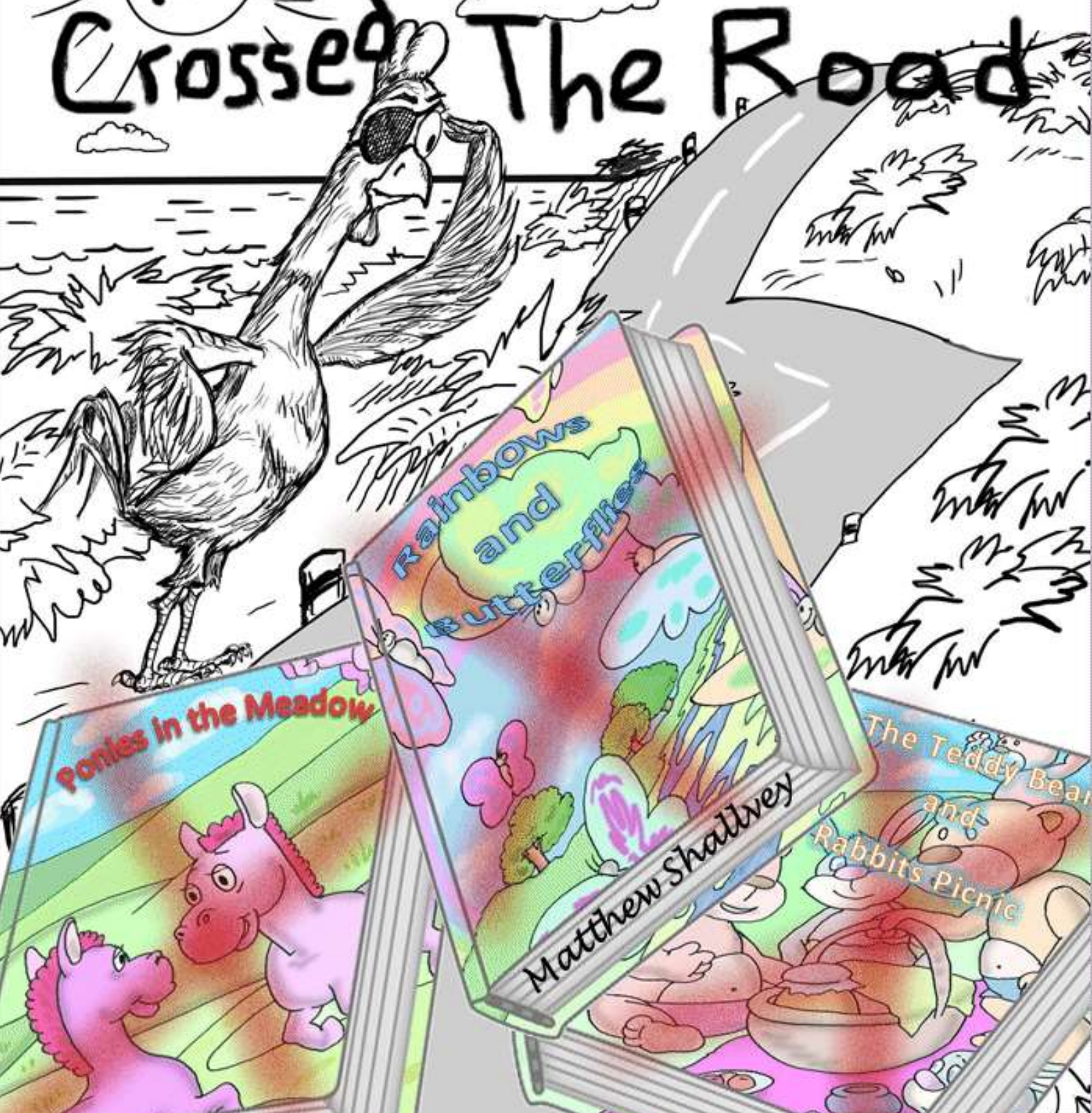

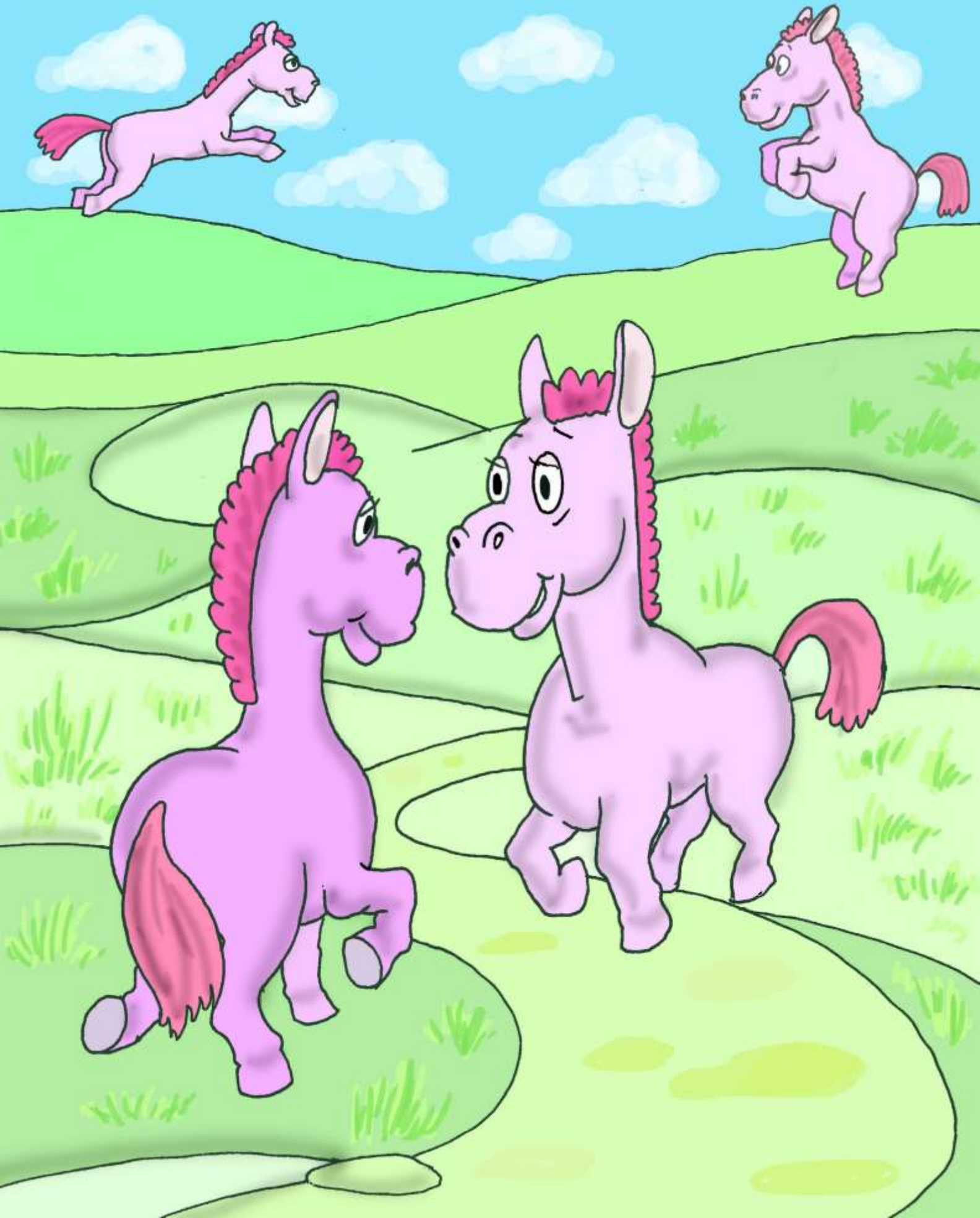

No. That's no good either is it?

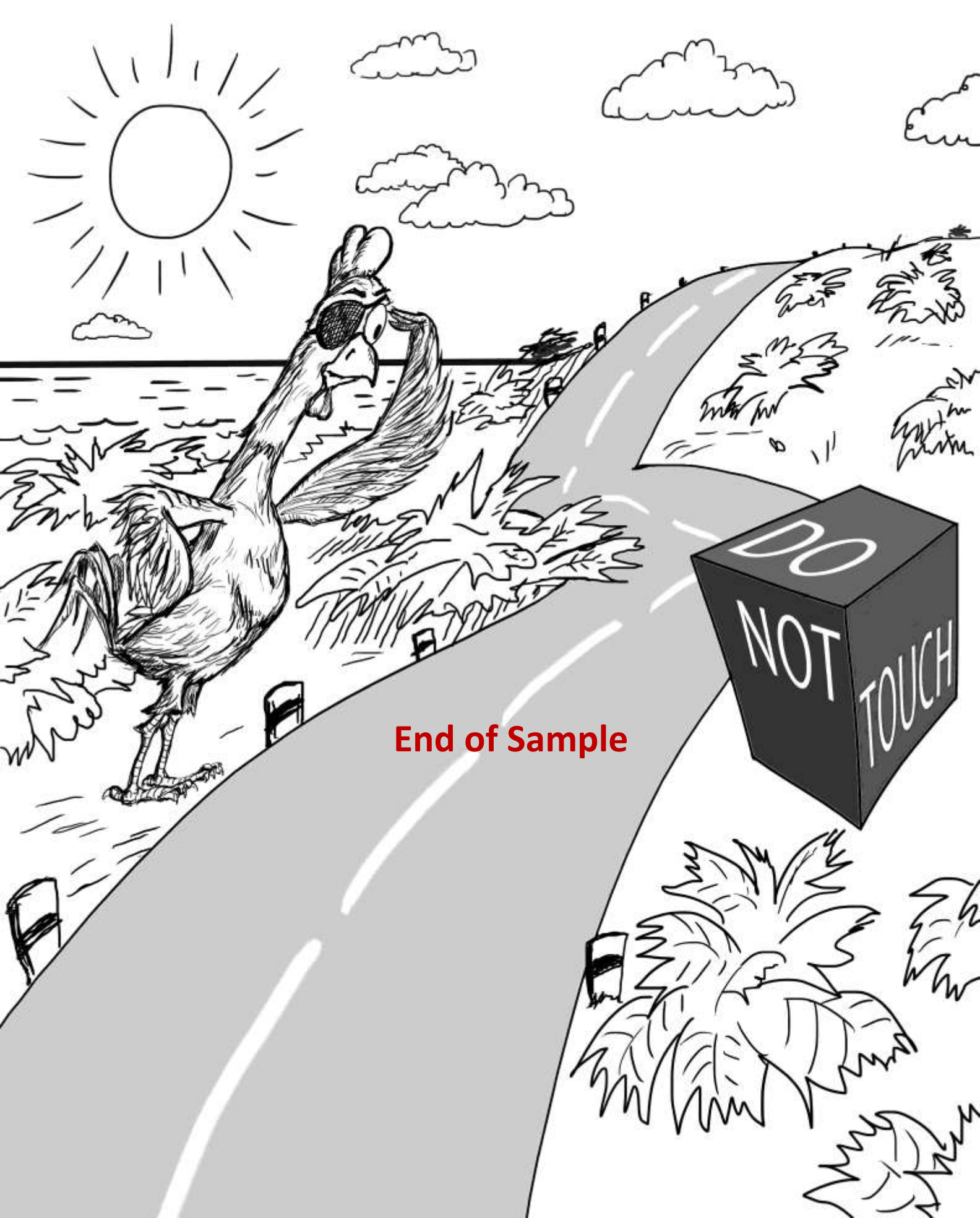
